

Notification: Annual Membership Renewal for 2020 Agami Inc.

Dear Agami Supporter,

We thank you for being a part of Agami and your continuous support.

This is a friendly reminder to pay your 2020 membership fee of **US\$50** as soon as possible in case you have not paid already. In order to be eligible to vote and/or run for a Board position, membership dues should be received 30 days before the election. The election date is September 25, 2020 and hence, all membership dues for eligible voting members should be paid by August 25th, 2020.

The following highlights from the Agami Bylaws (Article II Section 1) can be noted:

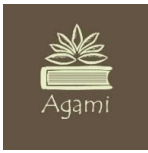
- ✓ A voting member must pay annual dues.
- ✓ Volunteers shall have no annual membership and shall have no voting rights.
- ✓ Volunteers may become voting members by paying annual membership fee.
- ✓ All voting members will constitute the General Body of Agami.

Please note here that the definition of membership period was recently revised by the Board of Directors on June 17th: *“The Board has decided to change the membership duration to calendar year.”* For example, in the new process, membership duration for year 2020 is from Jan 01 to Dec 31. With the transition to the new membership process, it will be a one-time exception for individuals who paid their dues after AGM 2019 (dated September 29, 2019), will have their 2020 membership extended until Dec 31, 2020 without any additional payment.

Also note that the AGM 2020 is being planned for October 4th, 2020. All (three) Board of Director (BoD) positions are up for election this year. Your membership needs to be in good standing to vote as well as to run for a BoD position. Any Executive Committee (EC) member, of Agami Inc. or its Chapter, also needs to be an Agami member in good standing.
